

## **Documents Required for Opening Personal / Joint Accounts**

Thank you for choosing the services of Nanyang Commercial Bank, Limited. Please note that the Bank requires the **original** of the following documents for account opening application.

### **I. Identity proof bearing your photograph<sup>1</sup>**

- Hong Kong Permanent Identity Card, or
- Hong Kong Identity Card **and** a valid international passport / travel document, or
- A valid international passport / travel document, or
- A valid Exit-entry Permit for Travelling to and from Hong Kong and Macau, **together with** the People's Republic of China Resident Identity Card, or
- Permanent Resident Identity Card of Macau Special Administrative Region.

**【Applicable To New Investment Service】Address proof<sup>2</sup> (bearing the same name as shown in the identity proof document)** Should applicants not be able to provide any of the documents listed above, the Bank would take into account the unique situation of the applicants and consider special arrangements.

#### Remarks

1. Apart from the proof of identity listed above, applicants may be required to provide below information and documents where necessary, including but not limited to:
  - a. Employment information including occupation, employer/business and monthly income
  - b. Purpose of account opening
  - c. Reasons for setting up account in Hong Kong
  - d. Expected number of transactions and transaction amount via this account
  - e. Source of funds
  - f. Jurisdiction of Residence & Taxpayer Identification Number or its Functional Equivalent
  - g. Valid residential address proof bearing your name
2. Residential address proof: Correspondence/statements issued by government authorities, public utilities companies or regulated banks in the last 3 months stating the customer's name and address etc..
