## Notice on Suspension of NCB Wealth Express <u>Card Service</u>

To cope with Nanyang Commercial Bank (China) Limited ("NCB (China)") business development, Nanyang Commercial Bank, Limited ("the Bank") will suspend its Wealth Express Card Service on 19 April, 2019 ("the Effective Date") until further notice.

Customers can continue to use other ATM card services provided by the Bank and NCB (China). For more details, please visit any of branches of the Bank or NCB (China), or visit the website of the Bank (www.ncb.com.hk) or website of NCB (China) (www.ncbchina.cn).

In addition, to satisfy customer needs of funds transfer, from now until 30 June 2019, the fee for remittance among the same name accounts between the Bank and NCB (China) through the branch counter is exempted. For **NCB Wealth Management** customers, the fee for remittance among the same name accounts between the Bank and NCB (China) through personal internet banking is also exempted\*.

Please note that other services (such as PPS and the Hong Kong Jockey Club Cash Coupon Service) registered with the Wealth Express Card issued by the Bank will also expire on the effective date. Customers can use other ATM cards for re-registration with the relevant service providers. If customers still hold the Wealth Express Card on or after the effective date, please destroy the card by cutting it in half through the chip and embossed card number.
